

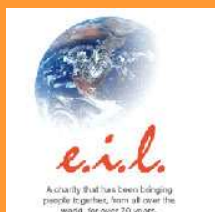


# European Voluntary Service On-Arrival Training

## On-Arrival Training Learning outcomes

By the end of the seminar you will:

- Have had the chance to consider your desired learning outcomes for your period of EVS & skills you may be able to offer to your host project
- Understand the funding structure of EVS and who are the key players
- Have had the opportunity to discuss your rights and responsibilities as an EVS volunteer
- Have information about the UK, it's history, cultures, food and climate, and also the chance to research a little about the specifics of the country (England or Scotland) and the region where you are based
- Have presented information to the group about where you are from and learnt about the countries other volunteers come from
- Be a little more prepared for culture shock and have at least begun the process of cultural immersion.
- Have considered with other volunteers & trainers different methods of problem solving and conflict and crisis management
- Have information on health & safety in your voluntary project and an understanding of your EVS insurance, the National Health Service and how to get medical help and/or treatment
- You will have visited a local community in the UK (possibly where you have not been before)
- Have discussed any worries, concerns or questions you have about the experience you are undertaking
