About the place

The project is located in a small isolated village called Sorkwity comprising of many traditional Polish country houses in the Masurian Lake District.

The centre is outside the main village surrounded by stunning natural landscape of the Piska woods and Lampasz lake.

The located isolation means the nearest shop is 5km away and the nearest disco 12km. The connections by bus are punctual and frequent and the capital Warsaw is served by a twice daily bus.

The local community is very open to tourists with much of the areas income derives from.
