Events & Festivals

Volunteers will have the opportunity to work in local community projects, arranging promoting & working at events & activities which will take place in the community

The activities may be focussed on children, arts, youth, music, culture, minority groups, history or environment, health for example. In addition to this you will be involved in Everything's Possible promotional events & seminars around Youth in Action.

There is the chance to work with a variety of community organisations who arrange regular or one off events. As a volunteer on this project you will have some flexibility in which events you work on and some will be arranged for you. Therefore if you have an interest in sports or music you can choose organisations who arrange such events.

Your role will involve a variety of practical work at events, such as setting out stages & exhibitions, handing out leaflets etc as well as more strategic preparation & evaluation.

Accommodation & Meals

Volunteers receive pocket money to buy food. Initially this is weekly in cash until we help you open a UK bank account. The accommodation you will live in has a kitchen and all utensils and equipment needed to prepare meals and also a washing machine, television & stereo (that may be shared between two flats). Volunteers will share a flat or house with other volunteers in Leeds or Bradford. You may need to use a bicycle to get between the accommodation and the project, we can provide you with this.

The accommodation is non-smoking and not all flats have a shower, some only have a bath. Long-term volunteers normally have their own bedroom but may have to be share with another volunteer for a short period.

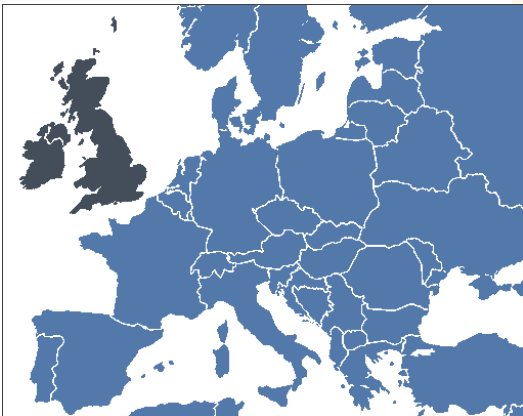

Leeds (where you will most likely live) is a major UK city, in West Yorkshire. Bradford (another City where we host volunteers) is a short drive away both close to the beautiful countryside of the Yorkshire Dales.

Leeds has undergone massive regeneration over the last two decades and as a result is a modern European metropolis with unique vibrancy and edge.

Bradford like many northern cities fell into industrial decline during the 1970's has since undergone massive regeneration over the last two decades and as a result is a modern metropolis with unique vibrancy and edge. The central location of Leeds & Bradford provides easy access to many other areas of the UK and is served by Leeds/Bradford International airport.

It offers the volunteer excellent opportunities for cultural exploration, arts, music and sports. The large student population adds to the city's dynamic. Leeds, and Bradford particularly has a high ethnic population which has enriched the culture of the city.
